### Planning a Financially Secure Future – The Mencap Trust Company Ltd

Julie Schwarz, Director of Mencap Trust Company will be presenting on Will and Trust options and Mencap Trust services to ensure you can plan a financially secure future for your young or older children. You will also be able to make an appointment to speak to Julie 1:1 if you wish, to discuss personal circumstances or find out further information.

### Seizure Genetics and Seizure Management in WHS

Karen Ho is Principal Scientist at Translational Research, Lineagen, Inc. and Scientific Advisory Board Member of several rare disease groups (4p-Support Group, Liv4theCure, KBG Syndrome, NGLY1.org, RUN, Utah Rare). Karen will present the results of a survey of antiepileptic drug responses providing insights into the link between genetics and the type of antiepileptic drug that will provide the best response.

### Support for Family Members Caring for Adults and Children with WHS - Katherine Vogt

Katherine Vogt is a researcher at Sheffield University. She has identified from interviews with UK parents, that there is a huge gap in support for family members caring for adults and children with WHS and has subsequently carried out a research report into the support provided and what is actually needed. She will present her research findings and the recommendations made as well as provide families with the opportunity to discuss them.

### Dr Alisdair McNeil

Senior Clinical Research Fellow, University of Sheffield Honorary Consultant in Clinical Genetics, Sheffield Children's Hospital. Alisdair will be taking over the reins from Dr Oliver Quarrell and will present on WHS genetics to **new-to-event attendees** and those who would like a refresher. Dr Oliver Quarrell will be joining us on Saturday too, so if you have any specific questions for him there will be the chance to speak to him directly.
